The application form can be downloaded from our website. Noted. The Senior Traffic & Safety Officer wrote to Cllr Belcher on March 3rd requesting further information. Noted with reference to Miss Franklin (March 5th) and Ken Jordan (February 24th) • Fletching Lane (Lane End common) – roadway falling away at side. – We have been unable to locate ‘Fletching Lane’. Please can we have more location information on this so we can investigate. ACTION: Location confirmed. Rob Stevens to investigate.
