10/106. To note Lewes District Council planning decisions and planning appeals and recommendations: A listing of planning application decisions received was circulated to members for consideration and noting.

10/107. Correspondence for Noting:

- Notice of cancellation had been received regarding the Public Enquiry Meeting concerning the Brickyard Lane footpath. A decision about the footpath would be made from written statements and supporting documents
- An update had been received regarding the West Sussex Minerals and Waste Core Strategy. Work on the strategy has been suspended due to uncertainties which have arisen recently, including the Localism Bill.
- NALC had provided guidance for Parish Councils concerning responsibilities for clearing snow and ice on the Highways (which was confirmed as the role of the Highway Authority).
- Lewes District Council had provided a Dog & Litter Bin Draft Policy consultation document which was circulated for comment. A response to the document is required by the end of February 2011.

10/110. Exchange of information:

• Cllr. Evans reported that the Church Commissioners were in discussions with Lewes District Council concerning the proposed plans for the conversion of St Mary's Church to a dwelling, in order to progress the matter further.

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- Cllr. Evans advised that a letter was to be submitted to the Parish Council regarding the commons fencing project and a request for funding to support the project.
- Cllr. Davies advised that the planning application for the play area at New Heritage had been approved.
- Cllr. Gould advised that the footpath at Whitegates had been resurfaced and much improved. However, the poor condition of Green Lane remained a concern. This matter would be raised at the forthcoming meeting with ESCC Highways.
- Cllr. Cowan reported damage to the bus shelter in South Chailey at Mill Lane. A high sided vehicle had hit the roof damaging roof tiles. It was suggested that a bollard could be placed in front of the shelter to prevent future damage. The central reservation adjacent to the bus shelter was also in very poor condition, caused by vehicles turning across the central island. This matter would also be raised with ESCC Highways.
- Cllr Evans reported an overgrown Hawthorn tree at A275 North Chailey Cross Roads.
- A site visit at North Common had been arranged for 12th December- to permit members to view common encroachment in the area and the impact that the proposed fencing would have.
